Important Notes:

1. In principle, it is not possible to change an option or complementary course once the definitive choice has been made.
 - a) In exceptional cases, the school may authorise a change provided it does not affect the organisation of classes (i.e. the change concerns a class that is already running).
 - b) Under no circumstances may a pupil withdraw, at the beginning of S6, from a class that has been created because the minimum required number of pupils was reached.
 - c) No changes will be permitted after Wednesday 16th September 2026.
 - d) No course dropping will be permitted after Wednesday 7th October 2026.
2. The 35-period limit may not be exceeded, except in the following cases:
 - Pupils whose compulsory timetable and option choices total 34 periods may select one additional 2-period complementary course.
 - Pupils choosing advanced scientific options (MA5 plus two science subjects) are subject to the same rule.
 The absolute maximum timetable is therefore 36 periods.
3. The course options listed on this grid are provisional and may be modified following decisions taken by the Management.
4. Pupils wishing to take a subject (e.g. Economics or another L3 or L4 course) which they have not studied during the previous two years must submit a written request to sit an entrance test on 20th May 2026. **This request must be sent to Jeff Pedley no later than 4 May 2026.**
5. If a 4-period science course cannot be offered in your language section due to insufficient numbers, it may be taken in another working language, where available.
6. All subject choices must allow for the inclusion of the two compulsory periods of EP.
7. In Row 8, please clearly indicate the course of your choice. If Religion is selected, the specific religion must be stated.
8. Pupils must choose a minimum of two option subjects in order to meet the minimum number of written subjects required for the European Baccalaureate. Students are advised to choose three option subjects in order to retain flexibility when selecting written examinations for the Baccalaureate.
