




Rules about subject choices

- **Total: min 31 ≤ Periods ≤ max 35**

Derogation: the limit of 35 periods may be exceeded to up to 36 periods

- **Core subjects** = Basic + options + advanced: **Min 29** periods
(= all subjects without complementary subjects)

- **4 periods option**: min **2** ≤ Options ≤ max **4**

Tip: 3 options give more flexibility for the BAC

Summary:

TOTAL:

- $31 < \text{Number of periods} \leq 35$
- *If Number of periods $> 35 \rightarrow$ Derogation*

CORE subjects = basic + options + advanced

- Number of periods ≥ 29
- $0 \leq \text{Number of Advanced courses (L1A, L2A, MATH)} \leq 1$
- $2 \leq \text{Number of Options} \leq 4$ (3 recommended)
- Minimum 1 Science
- History, Geography and Economics in L2 of S5 (even after changing L2)
- Science lab \leftrightarrow Science 4P and Advanced MAT \leftrightarrow MAT 5 P



 - Change in math: From S5 **short** Math to S6 **long** Math
 - Option in S6: Economy or L3, L4 without having followed the course in S4-S5

Choice of languages: Changes to be authorised by the Management

A change of L2 in S6 doesn't impact the language of teaching in history, geography and economics (still the former L2)

Minimum number of students to open a course

- 4 periods options: **5 students** minimum
- complementary courses: **7 students** minimum
- *No options, advanced or additional courses are guaranteed*
- *Wednesday afternoon classes in S6 and S7*



Some choices won't be compatible.

- Timetable: around **170** periods to fit in **40 periods** available per week:

- we have to create **blocks** of courses:

→ Some courses will be mutually exclusive.

We will create the blocks based on the majority of subject choices, so that the preferences of most students can be accommodated.

We can understand that having to give up a subject combinaison may be frustrating...

...But we are not in a position to do otherwise.

EEB2 is not an exception: no European school is able to fulfil 100% of the wishes of 100% of its students.



Timeline / Deadlines :

- **Parents:** info session at EEB2 – **28th November 2023 18h**
- **Final choices:** application to fill on extranet between January and **5th February 2024 (DEADLINE)**

Then:

- **determination of the groups that open or not (sufficient number of students)**
- **the combinaison of choices → adjustments...**
- **Creation of timetables: March to August 2024**
- **Timetable adjustment: September 2024**



...*After the deadline* (5th of February)

Requests of change from parents to be sent to Mr Leterme

Not all requests will be granted because:

- Grid of courses already created → some courses will be mutually exclusive
- Minimum number of periods for the student
- Minimum number of students in the course etc...

At the beginning of S6, exceptional request for change:

- Allowed only two weeks after the back to school day
- No request granted because the student doesn't like the teacher or want to chat with his/her friends

After the first two weeks of S6, we can't change anything!



How to choose my subjects?

- What do I see myself doing in 10 years' time?
- What are my interests, what kind of career do I imagine I will pursue?
- What am I good at?
- What kind of further education or training will I need? In what country and language?
- What preparation do I need in S6-7 for my choice of further education?
- What grades have I got so far in the subjects I am interested in?
- Do my teachers think I can succeed at the subjects I am choosing?
