**Timetables and periods** :

- From 8:30 to 4:10pm (9 ° period)

-Wednesdays 8:30 to 12:50 (S1 – S4)

- Number of periods per week: minimum 33 – maximum 35

- $\bigcirc$  1 period = 45 minutes
- ⊘ One break of 20 min. (10.55 11.15)
- ✓ Lunch time (12.05 13.40)



#### Subjects taught in L1:

- Mathematics: from S1 to S7
- Human Sciences: in S1 and S2
- Integrated Science: from S1 to S3
- BIO, CHE, PHY: in S4 and S5
- ICT/Religion/Ethics: in S1and S2



**The importance of L2** 

From S3: Human Sciences; Religion/Ethics;

From S4: Geo, His, Eco, Soc, etc.

The importance of the pedagogical continuity of L2 from P1 to S7 (BAC, 12 years).

No changes are envisaged in language choices, except on entry to year S6



#### **Introduction of L3**

2 periods in S1: This is a beginner's course and the choice is made in P5:

- German Portuguese
- Italian Spanish
- Dutch English
- French Another European lang.

- A minimum of 7 students to create an L3 course -

No changes are envisaged in language choices, except on entry to year S6.



#### **Optional Subjects**

- S1 No optional subjects
- S2 Latin (2 p)
- S3 ICT if they are not doing Latin
- S4-S7: ICT, L4, L5, Eco, Latin, Mus, Art, Soc, Labs, etc.

Irish: for Irish students in Anglophone Section Finnish: for Finnish students in SV Section Swedish: for Finnish students in FI Section
